

## **What is a Prosthodontist:**

Prosthodontists specialize in dental prosthetics and the restoration and replacement of missing or damaged teeth. They use prosthetic solutions including dental implants, dentures, crowns, bridges, veneers and oral sleep appliances to help patients improve their oral function, comfort, appearance and quality of life. With a three year additional residency beyond dental school, prosthodontists are highly trained restorative dentists and are prepared for even the most complex oral health issues. Whether it is chewing your favorite food, getting a restful night of sleep or creating the smile of your dreams, prosthodontists are your partners in health to restore smiles and confidence.

## **Your First Visit:**

Our goal at the initial consult is to get to know you, your dental health and your vision for treatment in a comfortable and compassionate setting. We will review your medical and dental history and listen carefully to your concerns and expectations. We will perform an exam to gather all of the information needed to comprehensively evaluate your long term dental needs. This may include an evaluation of your teeth, gum tissues, facial muscles, joints, screening for cancers and sleep disordered breathing, and typically requires radiographs. Collecting this information allows the prosthodontist to develop a few treatment plan options that are best for you. Depending on the complexity of your case, these options may not be presented until the following appointment.
